It helps to influence careers provision to allow young people to explore key aspects about a particular area. It is pivotal to effective careers guidance; high quality, impartial, current expert knowledge about local labour market information distinguishes careers support.

The Humber region is covered by four local authority areas on both sides of the Humber Estuary. These four councils are: Kingston upon Hull, East Riding of Yorkshire, North Lincolnshire and North East Lincolnshire.
